


And so the Taylor TurboChaser is born. But when it all goes suddenly wrong Amy is going to have to hit the road – and drive...



We laugh both at Mole and with him. A wonderful comic read, that, like all the best comedy, says something rather meaningful.







Will life ever get less unfair for Norm?


