

Dear Parents and Carers

Start of term 3 arrangements and timings

We have received a few queries about the staggered start. I hope that this letter will help to clarify the situation.

We need to stagger the return at the start of term in order to allow us to get all of our students through the test centre. Please read both sides of this letter to be clear on the system we are following. The start of term arrangements follow this testing schedule:

Students should first arrive at school <u>at the time slot indicated above for their tutor group</u>, regardless or not of whether their parents have given consent for them to be tested or not.

Students who need to be tested should report to the Sports Hall at the time slot they have been given above. Students who are exempt from testing, or who do not have consent for testing, should go straight to their normal lesson for their arrival time. Please bear in mind we will be returning during a timetable Week 2.

Whilst your child is waiting for their staggered start time to arrive, they should log on to Google Classroom and follow their timetabled lessons, wherever possible, to ensure that learning begins at the start of term.

So, as an example, if my child was in 10B1 they should log on to Google Classroom on both Tuesday 4th and for the morning of Wednesday 5th January, but leave home with sufficient time to arrive in school for 12.40pm when they will be expected at our test centre or in their normal classroom for a Week 2.

If my child was in 9A4 they will log on to Google Classroom for Tuesday 4th and Wednesday 5th and for lessons 1 and 2 on Thursday 6th January 2022, but leave home in time to arrive at our testing centre or in their classroom by 11.15am.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, you will receive a £2.50 Wonde voucher for each day they are at home during our staggered return to school.

I hope that this helps to clarify the situation regarding the return to school. Should you have any queries please ring contact the school in the normal way.
